At El Camino Middle School, we are committed to create and maintain a safe and respectful learning environment for all. Therefore, we ask that you help enforce the following dress code:

- Clothes should be clean, in good repair and appropriate for school activities. Clothing and jewelry must be worn in the way in which it was meant to be worn.
- Please consider others by not wearing colognes or other strong fragrances.
- No bandanas, head (sweat) bands, or hair nets are permitted on campus.
- Gloves may be worn outside only and must be worn on both hands.
- Baseball hats, visors and hoods may be worn outside only and must be worn in the correct way. Inside, hats and visors are to be put away.
- No saggy pants. Waist and inseam **must** match students' body measurements. No long or dangling belts, chains or spiked accessories are permitted.
- No halter tops, tube tops, spaghetti straps, see-through tops, low cut fronts or bare backs and midriffs.
- No short shorts or skirts. They should be no shorter than your fingertips when arms are hanging down at your sides.
- No clothing that promotes or advertises drugs, alcohol or tobacco use; depicts weapons of any kind, obscenity or lewdness; anything considered relative to gang attire, or is inflammatory in regard to race, religion, heritage or gender.
- No body glitter due to possible damage to computers.
- *Footwear must be safe and not limit participation in school activities. Thongs, flip-flops, or thin-strapped sandals may not be worn for outdoor play, athletic or other activities for which they are deemed unsafe or a threat to the healthy of the student or others. Extremely high heels may be dangerous on school grounds. (Board Policy 7132.2)*
- Any hats, apparel, or accessories that the Administration deems inappropriate will be confiscated.

Dress code violations will be treated like other infractions of the school's rules and regulations resulting in consequences beginning with lunch restrictions. If a student has a dress code violation, he/she will be required to change clothes. If a student fails to return violation clothing, they will be placed on the debt list.

REQUIRED SCHOOL SUPPLIES

- * Agenda Book which includes the Student Handbook will be given to each student to be kept in the student's binder.
